The loose change becomes grants in the Holston Conference to support new or existing ministries with economically disadvantaged children, birth to 12 years. The portion of loose change for Africa is used to build schools for children.

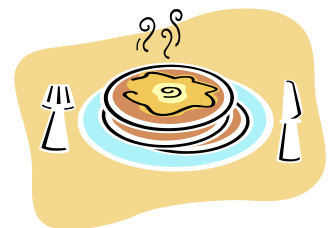
